## Troubleshooting

# You are experiencing slow or erratic network performance.

The antenna may not be receiving a strong signal. Keep the area around the antenna clear from materials that could block radio transmission, such as metal objects, electronic devices, and cordless telephones.

Changing the direction of the antenna may strengthen the wireless signal. Move your computer a few inches to receive a stronger signal. If this doesn't work, you may have to move your computer closer to the home gateway or access point.

Check your home gateway or access point to ensure that it is operating correctly. Make sure that there are no loose connections or cabling problems, and that the home gateway's or access point's antenna is working properly. You may have to consult the documentation that came with your home gateway or access point to check its operation.

# You cannot connect to your home gateway or access point.

Make sure that the "SSID" value of the Wireless Adapter is the same as the "ESSID" value of your home gateway or access point. See page 8 (Windows 98 SE), page 10 (Windows Me), or page 13 (Windows 2000) for more information.

Make sure that the encryption settings of your Wireless Adapter match the encryption settings of your home gateway or access point. See page 16 for more information.
