

Chapter 2 Remote Control

2.1. Air Keyboard AK03

Compact keyboard with gyro mouse and right/left clicks function.



You need to plug the receiver dongle into Simple Box USB ports.

Note: Plug in Air Keyboard dongle before usage.

When browsing Internet, you can press and hold the mouse left click to scroll on the web page as if using your finger to slide on a touch screen. Release the mouse left click to stop scrolling.



When you need to type characters, press "mouse left click" once in the text entry area to call virtual keyboard or use Air Keyboard to type directly. Press "Esc" on Air Keyboard to cancel virtual keyboard.




Press and hold the "mouse left click" in text entry area to select input method.











3.2 After turning on the device, you will see the cideko logo.



3.3 Later, you will see this Main Menu. It takes about 50 seconds to boot up successfully.



3.4 Insert pen drive or memory card, then it will show "New device is detected".



3.5 User can press button on remote controller to shut down power of Cideko Simple Box Advanced anytime, and press again to power up.

Chapter 4 Video Player

4.1 Press remote controller button to return to main menu and select "Video" icon.



4.2 Please select video source which you would like to play.



4.3 For example, files will be presented by folder list. Press " ◀ " and highlight the folder.



4.4 Press " ENTER / OK " to go into the folder and select the movie desired.




- 4.5 Use direction keys to select video and press " ENTER " button to start playing the video. Or you can also move the remote controller (AK03) and click mouse left click to start playing.

- 4.7 Press or by to fast forward or rewind.

- 4.9 Press or to turn the volume up or down.
- 4.10 Press to stop the video playing and press Home to go back to main menu.

Chapter 5 Photo Viewer

5.1 Press remote controller button to return to main menu and select "Photo" icon.



5.2 Files will be presented by folder list. Press " \mbox{ENTER} / OK " to go into the folder.



5.3 Use direction keys to select photo and press "ENTER" button to start playing the photo. Or you can also move the remote controller (AK03) and click mouse left click to start playing.



- 5.5 Press button to move to the next photo or go back to previous photo.

Chapter 6 Music Player

6.1 Press remote controller (Home) button to return to main menu and select "Audio" icon.



6.2 Please select audio source which you would like to play.






Press " • and highlight the folder.


6.4 Select one function, for example, "Songs" folder and press "ENTER / OK" to start the next step.

6.6 When in audio playing screen, press osk to call out function bar, to select "Play all", "Library" or "Shuffle all".



6.7 Press to mute.

6.8 Press or to turn the volume up and down.

6.9 Press Home to go back to main menu.

Chapter 7. Internet Browser

To use the Internet connection function, your Ethernet cable or Simple Box WiFi must be connected to an AP Router first.

7.1 Press remote controller (Home) button to return to main menu and select "Internet" icon.



7.2 If internet is available, the browser will connect to homepage, default is Google Search.



7.2a Use direction keys to select "searching bar" and press " ENTER / OK" button to call virtual keyboard.

Or you can also move the cursor (AK03) to "searching bar" and press mouse left click to call virtual keyboard.

7.2b Press " ESC " button to quit the virtual keyboard.

7.3 Press remote controller "Return" button to return to search menu and press "OSK" to call tool bar.



There are few sections, "Bookmark", "Refresh", "Forward", "Add bookmark", "Find on page", and "More".

7.4 Select "Bookmarks" to call the bookmarks. User can also select "Most visited" to show the bookmarks that you usually visit or "History" to show the bookmarks that you visited recently.



- 7.5 Select "New Window" to open new browser page...
- 7.6 Select "Add Bookmarks" to add the websites most viewed.
- 7.7 Select "Windows" to see all browser pages you opened.
- 7.8 Select "Refresh" to refresh current page.
- 7.9 Select "Forward" to next page.
- 7.10 Select "More" to select more functions.




Chapter 8 YouTube function

8.1. Press remote controller (Home) button to return to main menu and select "YouTube" icon.




8.2. Picture shows as below. You can choose videos to watch.

9.2.f. It will start proceeding and reboot the box.












10.2.c Ethernet configuration.





Chapter 11 Troubleshooting

If Android Simple Box Advanced does not work properly, when it goes to shut down and you can not boot it up. Please follow these troubleshooting methods.

- 1) Please visit Cideko website, **www.cideko.com** to have the latest firmware and save it to your SD card.
- 2) Please insert SD card to SD card slot of the box, you can see it on left side of the box.
- 3) Please press the button, "K9" from left side of the box without releasing.
- 4) Please plug in the power of the box.
- 5) Whenever you see new screen update, please release K9 button. The problem shall be solved now.

If Android Simple Box Advanced does not work correctly after the above steps are performed 3 times, please consult your dealer.
