## **Chapter 2 Hardware Installation**

#### 2.1 Hardware Installation

150M Wireless PCI-E card for desktop computer, follow proper installation methods.

1) Close desktop computer and disconnect the power. Open the main chassis, the motherboard selected an empty PCI-E slot, and remove the corresponding slot of the plate.

2) The card into the selected PCI-E slot, and verify that all card pin and socket contacts, as shown :



- 3) Screw the card to the chassis, and covered with the cover.
- 4) Plug the computer power, and start the computer.
