

Connecting the Cables

All wiring and configuration procedures explained in this document are also demonstrated with the animation that starts when you run the Air 6271 Easy Setup CD.

Please run the Easy Setup CD first.

- 1- Connect the power adapter provided to the power port of your router and plug it into the wall outlet
- 2- Turn on the Air 6271 by setting the On/Off switch to the "|" position.
- 3- Using the short telephone cable provided, connect the Modem port of the Splitter to the ADSL port of your router.
- 4- Connect the main phone line in your home to the Line port of the Splitter. If the main phone line is currently connected to your phone, first disconnect it from your phone, and then connect it to the Line port of the Splitter.
- 5- Using the short telephone cable provided, connect the Phone port of the splitter to the Line port of the Router.
- 6- Using the long telephone cable provided, connect your phone to one the Phone ports of the Router.
- 7- Using the Ethernet cable provided in the box, connect your PC to any one of the four Ethernet ports of your router.

When you are done connecting the cables, click "HARDWARE SETUP COMPLETE".

Step 2 To begin the configuration process, click "Next>" in the AirTies ADSL Utility Setup Wizard



Step 3 Enter the ADSL username and password assigned to you by your ADSL service provider. Fill out the Customer Information fields for warranty registration, and click "Next>".







Step 4. In the Wireless Settings section, you can configure the wireless security level, wireless network name (SSID), and password settings of your router. If you do not change anything, then the AirTies ADSL Utility will automatically configure wireless security settings and set a secure password for you. When you click "**Next>**", the ADSL Utility automatically stores your settings on your router and PC. You do not need to enter wireless settings on your PC.



Step 5 After your wireless security settings are saved, a screen that shows the wireless password for your router will come up. Please make a note of your password. Any PC that will wirelessly connect to your router will need this password.



Congratulations! You have successfully completed the ADSL and wireless configuration of your router. Now, you can enjoy wireless high speed Internet
