Before You Begin

If you purchased this Router to share your high-speed Internet connection with other computers, you must have an established Internet account from an Internet Service Provider (ISP). It's best to use the same computer that is connected to your router for configuring the DVA-G3340S Wireless ADSL VoIP Router. The DVA-G3340S acts as a DHCP server and will assign all the necessary IP address information on your network. See part 2 of this Quick Installation Guide or the Manual on the CD-ROM for setting each network adapter to automatically obtain an IP address.

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Connecting the Router to your Computer



- A. First, connect the power adapter to the power input at the back panel of the DVA-G3340S and then plug the other end of the power adapter to a wall outlet or power strip. Press the ON switch on the back of the unit. On the front of the device, the Power LED will turn ON to indicate proper operation.
- B. Insert one end of the Ethernet cable into an Ethernet (LAN) port on the back panel of the DVA-G3340S and the other end of the cable to an Ethernet Adapter or available Ethernet port on your computer.
- C. Insert the telephone cable included with the Router into the ADSL port, and then connect the cable to your telephone line.
- **D.** Check the LED display on the front of the Router to confirm that the connections have been made.



To connect to the network, make sure the network adapter in your computer is configured properly. Here's how to configure the network adapter to obtain an IP address automatically for the DVA-G3340S Wireless ADSL VoIP Router.

Enter your VoIP providers Server details into the **Server Address** field. Enter your VoIP Phone Number/ISN into the **Phone Number** and **Username** fields.

Enter your VoIP Password into the Password field.

You can also configure a second number into this device by filling in all of the Line 2 fields.

Click Next to continue.

Step 5: Save and Restart

This step will now save and restart the DVA-G3340S with the above changes we have made and try to establish your connection to the Internet and VoIP Provider.



Click the Restart button to save the settings and restart the router.
